In the performance of perfusion duties, the Chief Perfusionist oversees the day to day operation of Perfusion Services and participates with the ECLS Specialists in performing the technical duties involved in the maintenance and operation of cardiovascular perfusion, ECLS and related equipment for a variety of medical and surgical procedures in accordance with established standards, policies and procedures.

Example of Duties/Accountabilities

- Oversees the day to day operation of Perfusion Services by creating written protocols related to standards of practice and quality assurance with respect to equipment use and perfusion/ECLS to ensure adequate patient care. Conducts evaluations and long term planning; provides information for budget preparation; monitors the perfusion and ECLS budgets; attends and contributes to patient assessment and selection rounds; recommends capital equipment for purchase to the SDO or Medical Director of ECLS; prepares and maintains statistical reports regarding cardiovascular perfusion and ECLS and provides related data as required.
- Orders all general supplies and related equipment for Perfusion Services and the ECLS program via purchasing and/or suppliers.
- Supervises Perfusion Services staff and participates with ECLS team by preparing work and on-call schedules; planning and ensuring orientation and ongoing training; conducting performance appraisals for Perfusion Services staff and providing input into performance appraisals for ECLS specialists.
- Participates in the selection of new staff Perfusionists, Perfusion Assistants and ECLS Specialists through involvement in the interview and selection process.

Qualifications:

Education, Training and Experience

- Graduation from an accredited cardiovascular perfusion program; plus three (3) years recent related experience in perfusion including at least one (1) year of both supervisory and ECMO experience, or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
- Current certification with the Canadian Society of Clinical Perfusion.

Skills and Abilities

- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to deal with others effectively.
- Ability to organize work.
- Ability to operate related equipment.
- Physical ability to perform the duties of the position.
